IMPACT REPORT 2023







INTRODUCTION

This project was the pilot of our new initiative 'PWB produces'. As a registered charity, we partner with other organisations to apply for large grants and then mentor and backstop the process of setting up a project. We lend equipment, if required, and support with administration and technical support.

We partnered with Circus Central in Newcastle and Percy Hedley Foundation. We applied for the grant, managed the administration and mentored the staff. The team at Circus Central delivered the activities at their circus space to Percy Hedley and did the data recording after each session.

The project was a success and the arrangement worked well, demonstrating the great potential of this new model!

We will do more 'PWB produces' projects in the future and explore different Partner Organisations and funding possibilities. This model will hopefully help the Social Circus sector to deliver more circus for everyone.





SUMMARY

PWB and Circus Central provided circus workshops using circus toys, equipment and skills in new ways to create sensory experiences appropriate to the students. Workshop leaders worked with students and their support staff to facilitate sessions that were engaging, fun and stimulating for all.

We facilitated:

- 10 sessions
- Attended by 41 participants
- Totalling 200 hours
- For participants aged 18-25
